Call for Artistic Mural Proposal

Application Deadline: 8/23/21 at 12:00PM Noon

City of Atlanta - Mayor's Office of Cultural Affairs - Public Art Program

The City of Atlanta - Mayor's Office of Cultural Affairs (OCA) is currently seeking a muralist to paint an energetic and youthful styled mural at the Pittman Park Recreational Center. The community is interested in bright, uplifting artwork that is inviting to the youth entering the pool at Pittman Park.

This mural will cover the entrance to the pool at the Pittman Park Rec Center in the Pittman Park Neighborhood. Creatives and local artists are invited to submit qualifications and budget breakdowns through 12:00PM Noon EST, Monday, August 23rd.

Project Scope

We are looking for an artist or group of artists to paint an energetic and modern styled mural in the Pittman Park Recreational Center.

The community is interested in uplifting artwork that speaks to the youth of the neighborhood. The dimensions of the wall are shown in the image below. The OCA will power wash and prime the wall prior to artist start date. The selected artist is responsible for a clear, topcoat application over the entire mural once they have completed it. The clear coat will be provided by the OCA. The artwork should cover the entire area shown in the images below. The budget includes any assistants needed by the artists, paint, materials, and equipment.

- > 9/1/21 Project Start Date
- > 9/24/21 Mural Complete
 - * Selected Artist is required to immediately register as a vendor, submit paperwork including a quote for services, an invoice, and an E-Verify form, delay will result in the loss of commission.

Artist Eligibility

- > Experience in painting medium to large scale murals.
- All applicants, regardless of race, sex, religion, nationality, origin or disability will be considered.
- ➤ Open to local artists authorized to work in the U.S. The City of Atlanta participates in E-Verify and will provide the federal government with your W-9 information to confirm that you are authorized to work in the U.S.

Budget Breakdown

Artist payment: \$10,000.00

This covers the artist's payment, supplies, tools, equipment, and assistants (if needed).

Artist Submission

- CV/Resume (1 pg. maximum)
- Proposed Design
- Artist statement (1 pg. maximum)
- > A short statement explaining your concept for the artwork (1 pg. maximum)
- > 3 images of previous work

It is recommended that all should register as a <u>Spend Authorized</u> Supplier for the City of Atlanta: Register online anytime. Delaying registration will delay payment.
